Volunteer Policy

Volunteers help with the many tasks of the Bluefin Swim Club. Without the continued support of volunteers the club simply could not function and their time and commitment are greatly appreciated.

In order to become a volunteer with our club, it will be necessary to obtain the following;

1. Swim Ireland Membership which includes insurance
2. Garda Vetting – the Club will facilitate the Garda Vetting Form
3. Child Protection Course – the Club’s Education Officer will provide upcoming dates and venues

Swim Ireland Membership:

Bluefin Swim Club will meet the cost of the Swim Ireland Membership for the current year on the following understanding;

- You consent to act and remain an active volunteer for the full current year (October-October).
- If you decide not/are unable to continue to be a volunteer during the year, you agree that you will reimburse the club an amount proportionate to the value of the membership for the remainder of the year on request. Exceptional circumstances will be viewed sympathetically by the committee.
- You consent to your details being submitted to Swim Ireland for this purpose.

Garda Vetting

The Garda Vetting check is undertaken at no cost to yourself or the club, but personal details and identification must be submitted to a Bluefin Swim Club Committee member along with the Garda Vetting Application Form. The club will advise you when Garda Vetting has been completed.

Expense Reimbursements

The Club is not in a position to reimburse for any expenses incurred as a Volunteer without the prior consent from the Committee. If you anticipate expenses that you feel should be reimbursable, please email the Club Secretary with your detailed request and associated costs to be considered for Committee approval.
